- Create a profile all about you:

5 Career Aims – What do you want to do with the course? (Don't worry if you are unsure – just write down some careers you would be interested in).

6 Universities – I would like you to research and find out information about two universities you might be interested in, this needs to include UCAS points/entry requirements for courses you think you might be interested in attending after you leave sixth form.
