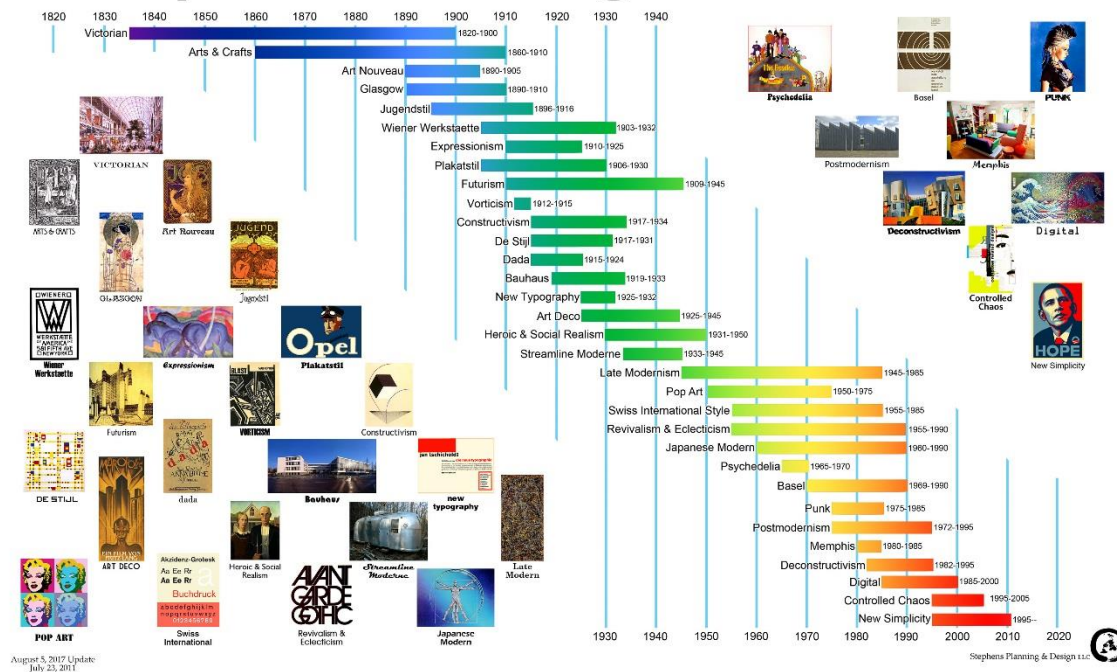


TRANSITION PACK 2 – A-LEVEL

The project is fun, but it's also a good opportunity for to show off lettering skills, and to demonstrate that you know how to think outside the box. Try making opposites e.g. a very plain own brand supermarket product is redesigned to look high end.
