I am writing to inform you of two events which we hope will be of value to both your son/daughter and yourself and will make the transition to Scarborough Sixth Form College as smooth and successful as possible.

1) **S6F Preview**

A one-day event for all applicants will now be held on **Thursday 1st July** (9am – 4pm) during which they can have a taster of up to four subjects.

Covid Rules – We will be following the guidelines from the Government. As these may change, we will contact you just before S6F Preview to confirm Covid requirements for the event.

S6F Preview is designed to give applicants the opportunity to be a college student for the day as well as find out more information about the subjects they wish to take. **If they are taking Sport, please could they come prepared with suitable kit (changing facilities are available).**

Lunch – The college café will be open throughout the day for applicants to purchase lunch, snacks and drinks. They can pay by cash or card. If your son/daughter has any specific dietary requirements, please email admissions@s6f.org.uk with the details.

Travel - During S6F Preview students can use the Sixth Form College contract buses. Bus drivers will normally accept a current bus pass or this letter as proof of attendance at the College. To see the bus timetables for the college buses, please go to: s6f.org.uk/travel

2) **Enrolment Interviews**

Final interview appointments for enrolment to the College will be held during the period **Tuesday 31st August – Wednesday 1st September** after GCSE results are known. This is when we will confirm your son/daughter's programme of study. We will send out appointments closer to the time.

Please note: we offer a Progression Year which consists of GCSEs and Level 2 Applied Generals for students whose GCSE results don't allow progression onto a level 3 programme.
